5 lb. BC Fire Extinguisher

NUMBER OF ESCORTS REQUIRED:

OVERHANG: If the overhang of the load exceeds 25' in front, a front pilot car is required for such a load. If the overhang exceeds 25' behind, a rear pilot is required.

HEIGHT: If the height of a load exceeds 15'6", one pilot car is required in the lead with a clearance pole for such a load.

LENGTH: If the length of a load exceeds 105' and travel is on a 2-lane or 4-lane highway, one rear pilot car is required.

WIDTH: If the width of a load exceeds 12' but is not more than 14' and travel is on a 2-lane highway, one front pilot car is required. If the width of a load exceeds 14' but is not more than 16' and travel is on a 2-lane highway, one front pilot car and one rear pilot car is required. If travel is on a 4-lane highway, one rear pilot car is required. If the width of the load exceeds 16' but is not more than 17' and travel is on a 2-lane highway one pilot car is required in the lead, one front pilot car is required and one rear pilot car is required for such a load. If travel is on a 4-lane highway, one front pilot car and one rear pilot car is required. If the width of a load exceeds 17', pilot cars will be required for such a load in an amount determined by the department.

It is the responsibility of the permittee to ensure that pilot car vehicles, operators or flagmen employed to carry out the provisions of the permit are properly equipped and briefed as to their responsibilities

prior to the movement. Failure of the pilot car operators and flagmen to comply with this section with proper warning and directing traffic is considered a violation of the terms of the permit. If the provisions of a permit require a flagman to warn and direct approaching traffic, the flagman must: be at least 18 years of age; wear appropriate protective clothing, including, without limitation, a vest which is constructed of solid, fluorescent yellow-green material and which completely covers the flagman's torso and be equipped with a stop & slow sign.

TRAVEL TIMES/RESTRICTIONS:

Daylight hours defined as 1/2 hour BEFORE Sunrise to 1/2 hour AFTER Sunset.

The following holidays must be observed and permits will not be issued for the movement of mobile homes, modular homes and houses if they exceed 10' in width and other loads that are oversized in width or length on these days: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Admission Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and any day that may be designated by the President of the United States or the governor for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday.

TRAVEL PILOTING/ESCORTING DISTANCES:

Front Car: 300'-1000', Rear Car: 100'-1000'

HEIGHT POLE REQUIREMENTS:

Required at load heights: 15'6"
