NUMBER OF ESCORTS REQUIRED:

Escort vehicles are required for operation on 2-lane roads with traffic in both directions and multi-lane divided highways with 2 or more lanes in each direction with shoulder for: Wide load 12' or more, usually 1 car; Over 14' high a height pole will be determined by the DOT if needed. Super Loads 2 cars or police escort required; Long load 80' or more; Overhang 15' or more; escorts required at 12' wide, 80' length, 15' overhang (On a 2-lane the escort will be in the front, on a 4-lane the escort will follow).

TRAVEL TIMES/RESTRICTIONS:

Daylight hours 1/2 hour BEFORE Sunrise to 1/2 hour AFTER Sunset. Saturday, Sunday and Holiday Operation: On state highways unless otherwise stated, permits will not be issued for movement of loads in excess of 108,000 lbs., or over 10'6" wide or over 100' long on any Saturday, Sunday, any Friday afternoon between July 1 and Labor Day, or on the following legal holidays as observed by the state of Vermont: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Columbus Day, Martin Luther King Day, Independence Day, Veteran's Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, President's Day. If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a legal holiday. If a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday is a legal holiday and these days are restricted as other holidays. Travel with vehicles and/or loads which are overwidth or over length or over height shall be restricted to daylight hours. Overweight vehicles can travel 24 hours a day. See general provisions for special instructions on provisions sheet or permit.

CURFEW: Rutland - US 4 - No travel between 7:00-9:00 am and 3:00-6:00 pm. Route 107 - School day restriction only. No travel allowed before 8:30 am and between 11:00-12:30 pm and 2:00-5:00 pm. As a result of legislation passed in 2000 there have been a number of changes in the rules governing truck lengths and length permits in Vermont. For more information call 802-828-2064.
