## NUMBER OF ESCORTS REQUIRED:

Escorts are required on Primary and Secondary highways when movement is 110' or greater in length or 14' or greater in width, or will extend to the left of center during movement. Escorts are required on interstate highways for widths of 15' or greater. Escorts for height on all highways and for length on interstate highways are at the discretion of the approving authority. Usually loads over 17'6" or higher in height require a height pole, may be at the discretion of the district office or officer in charge.

## TRAVEL TIMES/RESTRICTIONS:

Daytime travel from 1/2 hour BEFORE Sunrise to 1/2 hour AFTER Sunset. Movements requiring escorts will not be permitted to travel from 1/2 hour after sunset the evening before a holiday to 1/2 hour before sunrise the day after the holiday. The holidays are: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. When a holiday is combined with a weekend for a three-day weekend, these restrictions will be in force from 1/2 hour after sunset the day preceding the holiday weekend through 1/2 hour before sunrise the day following the holiday weekend. When a holiday falls on a Saturday, no moving requiring escorts will be permitted from 1/2 hour after sunset Thursday to 1/2 hour before Sunrise Monday and when a holiday falls on Sunday, no move requiring escorts will be permitted from 1/2 hour after sunset Friday to 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday. Loads can travel at night up to 10' wide and over 60' long, if lighted and signed on interstate highways only.
